NSS Camp, Orientation on My Bharat Youth Portal, and Awareness Camp on Vikshit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025

Introduction:

On 11th March 2025, the NSS Unit-1 of Raidighi College successfully conducted a multi-purpose event that included three major activities:

- 1. Registration Camp for New NSS Volunteers
- 2. Orientation Session for Volunteers on the My Bharat Youth Portal
- 3. Awareness Camp on the Vikshit Bharat Youth Parliament (VBYP) 2025- Mega Event

The event was part of a national initiative to promote youth engagement in nation-building and community development. With over 150 students actively participating, the session was both informative and impactful.

Event Objectives:

The primary goals of the event were:

- To enrol new students into the NSS and educate them about its vision and objectives.
- To guide volunteers in registering and navigating the My Bharat Youth Portal.
- To raise awareness about the **Vikshit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025 (VBYP-2025)** and its nationwide campaign aimed at youth empowerment and participation in civic matters.

Session Highlights:

1. Registration of New NSS Volunteers:

The program began at 11:30 AM sharp with a welcoming address by the NSS Programme Officer, **Dr. Arvinda Shaw**. More than 150 enthusiastic students gathered to enroll as NSS volunteers. The Programme Officer highlighted the significance of NSS in the development of both individual character and the community at large.

Key Points Discussed:

- NSS as National Service Scheme under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India.
- The motto of NSS: "Not Me, But You", emphasizing the spirit of selfless service.
- Objectives of NSS: character building, leadership development, civic responsibility, and national integration.
- Role of youth in nation-building and the significance of voluntary service.

After the briefing, **111 new students successfully registered** themselves as NSS volunteers. Volunteers were guided through the formal process and provided with necessary documentation and instructions for further participation.

2. Orientation on My Bharat Youth Portal:

The second session focused on familiarizing the new volunteers with the **My Bharat Youth Portal** – a unified platform initiated by the Government of India to connect, engage, and empower the youth across the nation.

Topics Covered:

- Purpose and Vision of the My Bharat Portal.
- How to **create a profile**, **update activities**, and **participate** in national-level youth programmes.
- Features of the portal such as skill development opportunities, community engagement, and national challenges.
- Importance of digital literacy and active online civic engagement for today's youth.

Volunteers were individually assisted in creating their personal profiles on the portal using mobile phones and college computer systems. This hands-on orientation enabled the students to explore the portal's functionalities and encouraged them to stay connected with ongoing youth initiatives nationwide.

3. Awareness Camp on Vikshit Bharat Youth Parliament (VBYP)-2025:

The final part of the program was dedicated to creating awareness about the **Vikshit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025**, a Mega Event aimed at bringing youth voices to the forefront of India's development discourse.

Highlights:

- Overview of VBYP-2025 and its objectives.
- Importance of youth participation in democratic processes.
- Encouraging critical thinking and expression through speech and video presentation.

Dr. Arvinda Shaw encouraged all registered volunteers to actively participate by submitting a **1-minute video** on the theme "What does Vikshit Bharat mean to you?" through their My Bharat Portal profile. Volunteers were briefed on:

- How to conceptualize and script their message.
- Technical guidelines for recording the video.
- Steps to upload it on the portal.

The session highlighted how initiatives like VBYP help shape a youth-led vision for a **developed India**, or "Vikshit Bharat", by 2047 — marking 100 years of independence. The idea is to capture the aspirations of young India and empower them to contribute meaningfully to society.

Participant Feedback and Reflections:

Many students expressed their enthusiasm about becoming part of the NSS and appreciated the exposure to national platforms like My Bharat and VBYP. Here are some reflections:

- Ankita Das (1st Year BA): "This was my first time attending an NSS event, and I am inspired to contribute more actively to my community."
- Rahul Mondal (2nd Year BSc): "Learning about My Bharat Portal and VBYP gave me a sense of purpose. I'm excited to submit my video."

Outcomes of the Programme:

- 111 new students were officially enrolled as NSS volunteers.
- All new volunteers were successfully introduced to the My Bharat Portal.
- A majority of students pledged to participate in **VBYP-2025** through video submissions.
- The event instilled a greater sense of **national responsibility**, **civic awareness**, **and self-development** among the participants.

Conclusion:

The NSS Camp conducted at Raidighi College on 11th March 2025 was a resounding success. Through structured orientation and interactive sessions, students were not only inducted into NSS but were also empowered with the tools and platforms necessary to shape the future of the nation.
