Introduction:

A Free Thalassemia Detection Camp was organized on 2nd April 2025 by Raidighi College NSS Unit-1 in collaboration with **Diamond Harbour District Hospital & Amra Rakta Yoddha Group** at Raidighi College to provide early screening and increase awareness of Thalassemia among the students, teaching and non-teaching staff members. During the camp, High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) tests were conducted for free on all participants to detect hemoglobin disorders such as Thalassemia minor, major, and other variants.

HPLC Report Distribution:

The HPLC test reports were distributed to all participants on 15th and 16th May 2025 from the Department of Food and Nutrition, Raidighi College. The distribution process was carried out in a well-organized and systematic manner to ensure that all participants received their reports in a timely and confidential manner.

Process Overview:

1. Notification to Participants:

All participants were informed via phone calls/sms about the availability of their test reports and the schedule for distribution.

2. Verification of Identity:

Participants were required to present their registration slips or valid ID (Aadhar card) to collect their reports.

3. Report Distribution:

Reports were handed over by camp volunteers maintaining strict confidentiality.

4. Counseling and Guidance:

The identified Thalassemia carriers were referred to a qualified healthcare professional of Raidighi Rural Hospital for proper counseling and awareness about their health status.

Conclusion:

The distribution of the HPLC test reports was carried out efficiently and with due diligence. Participants appreciated the initiative, especially the free testing and counseling services. Those with positive findings were given appropriate referrals and medical guidance for further follow-up.

This initiative has played an important role in creating awareness about Thalassemia and promoting the importance of carrier detection and genetic counseling. The organizing team expresses sincere thanks to all participants, volunteers, and medical professionals who made the camp and report distribution a success.
